A Message From Karen Pear

Every time I walk in the door of God's Love, I am reminded of how lucky I am to work at such a magical place. We are supported by so many generous friends who believe in our life-saving mission, as well as over 15,000 volunteers annually whose dedication and hard work continue to amaze me. Our volunteers give us the most precious gift possible – the gift of time – and we are grateful every day for their enthusiasm and commitment. As we enter this very special time of year, I am particularly grateful.

Advocacy is another way to help those who need us most. Over the past few months, our advocacy team has been out in the community spreading the word about who we are and what we do. We have been making presentations that demonstrate thought leadership in the field of medically tailored meals, as well as educating our supporters about healthcare trends and our work to integrate medically tailored meals into the healthcare system.

We have also been working hard to help get a bill passed in New York State that would provide funding for medically tailored meals in the Medicaid statute. We have traveled to the State Capitol in Albany to meet with elected officials and discuss our work and its positive impact on health outcomes and healthcare system costs.

God's Love serves as the convener of the Food is Medicine Coalition (FIMC), an association of nonprofit medically tailored food and nutrition service providers. Each September, we coordinate the FIMC National Symposium in Washington, D.C., where we discuss exciting new research in our field, best practices guiding our programs and services, and cement our policy priorities for the year. The social determinants of health are receiving increasing attention in the healthcare community, so this year's convening felt momentous.

Thanksgiving Day at God's Love has become extra special for the thousands of clients we serve throughout the year—4,000 on a typical day, and more than 7,500 in a year. This year, each of our clients will receive a delicious, lovingly-prepared Thanksgiving meal, plus a guest meal to share with a friend or loved one. We believe that no one should have to spend the holiday alone. Each client will also receive a festive, God's Love branded gift bag filled with snacks to enjoy during the holiday to remind them we care. Knowing that we reduce the isolation often felt by our clients makes this day at God's Love even more meaningful.

Cooking and delivering holiday meals is a huge community effort, and with your support, we will cook and deliver

an estimated 8,000 Thanksgiving meals this year. None of this would be possible without the help of some 1,300 volunteers on Thanksgiving Day itself and many more in the weeks leading up to the holiday. 

Delivering Love to Angela

Originally from Jamaica, Angela moved to Brooklyn a few years ago. She loves reading Agatha Christie murder mysteries and watching sports, particularly basketball. A former New York Knicks fan, she has now transferred her loyalty to the Brooklyn Nets.

Angela loved her work as a property manager. Climbing up stairs and down fire escapes and inspecting rooftops, she loved its demanding physicality and how every day was different. But after Angela was diagnosed with breast cancer, her whole life was turned upside down.

Cooking and shopping for herself became impossible. Her medication leaves her dizzy. She is so exhausted that she can no longer climb stairs. Following her lumpectomy, Angela had nine months of chemotherapy and radiation. Today, she is undergoing hormone therapy and there have been troubling side effects: Severe neuropathy in her feet and hands, and dizziness from her medication.

She tells us, "When I get up in the morning, my feet are crying. It's like you're standing on stones or something sharp. I drop things – things fall out of my hands."

Angela learned about God's Love through an outreach person at the American Cancer Society. Immediately she began receiving medically tailored, home-delivered meals from God's Love. All of a sudden, everything she'd been struggling with became much

"Breast cancer made things so much more difficult for me," she says. "Cooking is out of the question. I can't stand for a long time and I feel lightheaded over a hot flame. I know I can count on your delicious meals in my freezer. It's good for me, I look forward to it, and I don't have to worry."

Her cholesterol has gone down since she joined our program. She loves her Thanksgiving meal delivery that comes in a bag hand-decorated by kids. Our Nutrition team members have worked closely with Angela to provide her with a vegetable-rich diet she loves.

"The staff have been helpful in making these meals just for me. I love that it's an already-prepared meal, and I don't have to do anything but heat it up." Angela is grateful for the ease and relief our meals bring to her and her life, and she's also thankful for all the people who make this possible.

I know I can count on your delicious meals in my freezer. It's good for me, I look forward to it, and I don't have to worry."



PROGRAM:

Breast Cancer Program Helps Women and Families

October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month, and every year we take this opportunity to spread the word about our services for individuals and families affected by breast cancer.

The side effects of cancer treatments make it difficult to eat well, and malnutrition can complicate breast cancer treatment, making it harder to recover. Our Breast Cancer Program delivers nutritious meals for households affected by breast cancer. Our meals are individually tailored to meet the nutrition needs of patients undergoing treatment, helping them to regain their strength and independence.

When one person is sick, the whole family is affected. For the children of parents who are too sick to shop or cook for their families, we provide child-friendly dinners, as well as breakfast kits to help kids start the day right. We also provide meals for senior caregivers who are struggling to meet their own needs while caring for a sick loved one with breast cancer.

Our dietitians track clients' health and medical treatments to offer the right food at the right time, including soft, minced or pureed food for those who may have trouble chewing and swallowing. We produce nutrition guides specifically for breast cancer patients and survivors which we share with clients, community-based organizations and healthcare providers.

Nancy, a client of our Breast Cancer Program, recently shared her story about how God's Love makes a difference in her life. Nancy is a 42-year-old single mom with a 15-year old son. When Nancy was diagnosed with breast cancer on top of a lupus diagnosis, everything changed. "I had lost all energy to

do something as simple as walking," she says. "I have to rely on someone else to do things for me and I'm not used to that. I lost so much weight." Nancy found herself isolated and depressed.

Nancy began receiving meals from God's Love and she feels each meal has made her a little bit stronger. Working with a dietitian, Nancy says our program "helped me to figure out a lot of things – what to eat to try to keep the weight on."

There are many more stories like Nancy's in our Breast Cancer Program. In the past year we cooked and delivered 82,730 meals for 313 breast cancer patients, their children, and their senior caregivers. We rely on our wonderful partners—Komen Greater NYC, New York Community Trust, and others—to keep this program going. This year's festive holiday meal will be corn chowder, braised beef, and, for dessert, a holiday sprinkle cookie. We will also offer fish, vegetarian, and minced or pureed options (for those with chewing difficulties) so that every client, child or guest can enjoy a special meal. We are happy to report that we had many compliments from clients on this new menu. Our Executive Chef Daniel Metzger says: "Food is Medicine, but it doesn't have to taste like medicine!"

VOLUNTEER:

Second Helping with Eva Wirth

In 1993, Eva received an appeal letter from God's Love. At the end of the letter it asked if she'd like to learn about volunteering. Deeply concerned about the AIDS crisis and looking for a way to give back, she checked the box yes. And the rest is history!

Eva had lived in the East Village during the late 80s and saw first-hand the toll the AIDS pandemic took on the city around her. In just a few short years, the entire community landscape around her changed. When she received her letter from God's Love, she knew that it was time to roll up her sleeves and give back to support those around her. She'd been in a difficult place in her life and she knew that helping others could positively change how she felt.

Eva still remembers the first time she walked into our kitchen at the American Youth Hostel on 103rd Street and Amsterdam. She remembers how small the kitchen was.



but how bright and energized it felt. It was a Monday night and she met some of the regulars including Judith Schasberger and Norma Grant, both of whom still volunteer at God's Love all these years later.

After 10 years of volunteering Eva took a break. In 2007 she was diagnosed with breast cancer. She endured six weeks of radiation. While she'd always been active as a cyclist, swimmer, and runner, she changed her diet according to her doctor's advice.

Last year, Eva found her way back to God's Love. She met our Board of Trustees member Bill Ribbecke at Orangetheory Fitness. Like the true God's Love ambassador he is, Bill mentioned his work with us to Eva and she decided to sign back up. Now, Eva has made Wednesday afternoons her weekly shift, but fills in on other shifts too.

And Eva's commitment at God's Love doesn't stop at the kitchen. In September she participated in the Douglas Elliman Ride for Love.

Eva continues to feel the change God's Love has made in her life, from introducing her to so many kind people, to giving her important and impactful work, and to helping change her outlook on life.

It's like my happy place. I've met so many nice people that care about each other through God's Love. We bring out the best of New York. I'm so glad to be here."

Leading the Field in Food is Medicine

God's Love We Deliver acts as the convener of the Food is Medicine Coalition (FIMC), an association of nonprofit medically tailored food and nutrition service providers. Each September, we coordinate the Food is Medicine Coalition National Symposium in Washington, D.C. This Symposium is made possible by generous funding from the MAC AIDS Foundation. This past September, we successfully hosted our 9th Annual Symposium. This year's symposium felt particularly momentous because of the widespread attention that the social determinants of health are receiving in the healthcare community. The Symposium gave us the chance to come together and reflect on the past year, discuss exciting new research, learn about the innovative work being done across the country, and advocate for policies that expand access to medically tailored meals.

This year, there was no shortage of expert guest speakers. Former NYS Medicaid Director and Partner at Manatt Health. Deborah Bachrach, joined us to discuss Medicaid's role in addressing the social risk factors that influence health. Senator Bob Casey Jr. of Pennsylvania provided us with opening remarks to kick off our Hill Visits where FIMC agencies meet with elected officials to educate them about the medically tailored meal intervention and the work of the Food is Medicine Coalition. And finally. we had the pleasure of receiving closing remarks from Congressman Jim McGovern of Massachusetts who co-leads the Food Is Medicine Working Group of the House Hunger Caucus. Representatives from the Center for Health Law and Policy Innovation at Harvard Law School, AIDS United, Manatt Health, NASTAD, Nonprofit Finance Fund, Northwestern Medical Center, Unite Us, and Kaiser Permanente also presented.

Amid planning for a National Symposium, the Policy & Planning team took our message on the road, presenting at several national conferences. In August, Alissa Wassung, Director of Policy & Planning, was in



Washington, DC, presenting at the convening of the National Resource Center on Nutrition & Aging, alongside colleagues from the Center for Health Law & Policy Innovation at Harvard Law School, Community Servings in Boston and Project Angel Heart in Denver. Collectively, partners addressed the need to nourish seniors through medically tailored meals.

Alissa also presented in August at the American Sociological Association's annual meeting with our colleagues from Columbia University's Mailman School of Public Health on a panel titled Food Insecurity and HIV/ AIDS. Alissa discussed our joint research, as well as the need for additional support for research in the field of nutrition.

Each year, God's Love We Deliver is honored to present at the United States Conference on AIDS (USCA). This year Karen made her way to DC to join our Food is Medicine Coalition colleagues on a panel titled Food is Medicine: Addressing Access Barriers through Nutrition Services. Karen discussed the development of the Food is Medicine Coalition's national nutrition standards for medically tailored meals, which were recently adopted by the NYC Health and



Human Services Planning Council to improve the quality of food for people living with HIV.

To finish out a busy summer and fall conference season, Alissa will join our Food is Medicine Coalition partners at the end of October at the Root Cause Coalition's 4th Annual Summit on the Social Determinants of Health: Health Equity in our Time. Alissa and partners will host a Pre-Conference Institute titled Addressing Health Inequities through Innovative Partnerships Providing Access to Food is Medicine Interventions. The Root Cause Coalition Summit provides an opportunity for healthcare providers and community-based organizations to come together and discuss the social determinants of health and learn from the innovative partnerships taking place across the country.

For years, we have continuously stressed the importance of nutrition as a social determinant of health. We are so pleased that this concept is receiving the national attention it deserves and we hope that these educational opportunities serve as a catalyst for bringing our life saving services to more people in need.

Soup: It's more complicated than you think! by Lisa Zullig, MS, RDN, CSG, CDN

You probably know that our handmade soups have been a significant part of our meal program for many years. But you might be surprised at how much thought goes into every batch of soup that we cook!

In past years, staff cooked all soups in large commercial kettles. Once cooked, soups were then packed into individual containers. Despite the best efforts of our staff and volunteers, we noticed that the proportion of ingredients was not always equal from one serving to the next. Preserving our nutritional standards and quality are essential, which led us to develop a new method of production and pack-out. Our teams are now in the process of transitioning all non-puree soups to this new system.

The effort began with the development and analysis of new soup recipes by the Culinary & Nutrition teams. These new recipes, along with some of our tried and true favorites, make up our current soup menu. The Nutrition team crunched the numbers in an innovative way, creating

nutritional templates for pack-out. Next, our Chefs completely revised production so that ingredients are cooked individually or in groups. The desired portion of each is then added to the individual soup containers along the pack-out line by volunteers and staff, resulting in a standard product.

As always, we make sure that our clients enjoy a variety of vegetarian, chicken and beef soups, along with our entrees, breads, and desserts. Each soup provides an excellent portion of vegetables, along with grains and protein.

Communication to our staff and volunteers has been key to this transition. Our Culinary and Nutrition teams introduced the new process along with its benefits to all stakeholders, and as the process is tested and refined, both staff and volunteer input has been extremely helpful.

Once fully implemented, following this new soup production and pack-out system will result in



a more reliable product. This is not only a benefit to our clients, but it is also a boon for overall efficiency and our ability to serve all who need us.

NUTRITION RECIPE:

Chicken Corn Chowder

Chowders, a classic in the thrifty cooking arsenal, are hearty soups which are served as a meal. Our chefs here at God's Love prepare a version of the traditional corn chowder with added chicken. This recipe results in a healthy, savory and filling meal designed to warm the hearts of our clients.

- 1 pound chicken, thigh, meat only, raw
- 1 cup corn, sweet, frozen
- ½ cup carrots, diced
- ½ cup celery, diced
- ½ cup parsnip, raw, diced
- 1½ pounds potatoes, sweet, cubed
- 6 cups chicken stock
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- Kosher salt
- Pepper

Preparation

- 1. In a large pot, heat the olive oil.
- Season chicken with salt and pepper, add to pot, cook until slightly browned and no longer pink.
- 3. Add the carrots, celery, and parsnip, season with salt and pepper, stir for about 6 minutes or until tender.
- 4. Add chicken stock to pot, bring to a simmer.
- 5. Add in the cubed potatoes and simmer for 10 minutes, then add the corn.
- 6. Stir and combine and let simmer for about another 10 minutes or until soup begins to thicken.

Transforming Partnerships at God's Love

While many people who receive our meals live alone, in other cases an entire household is struggling. A mother with cancer still needs to care for her young children. Also, seniors on our program might live with a senior caregiver who is overwhelmed. Macy's, a wonderful partner at God's Love through grants and volunteerism, is now supporting our Family Meal Program, helping deliver breakfasts and child-friendly dinners for our clients' children, as well as meals for our senior caregivers.

Our staff members all work on Thanksgiving to bring clients and their guests a delicious turkey dinner with all the trimmings and a gift basket filled with non-perishable treats like granola bars, raisins and applesauce. Both the Binn Family Foundation and the Krumholz Foundation are longtime partners

helping us deliver the joy of the holiday. AXA Equitable Foundation joined our Thanksgiving effort this year as well!

Much work goes on behind the scenes so that our program can to continue to grow. This means staying up to date with our technology, our evaluation techniques, and the data management needs of our contract partners. Earlier this year the Altman Foundation awarded us a grant for technology upgrades to build our organizational capacity, and expand our ability to conduct research. And the New York Community Trust—a longtime partner of our cancer program—recently pitched in to help us develop a new client management system that will help us serve more Medicaid clients, while assessing the efficacy of medically tailored meals for those on Medicaid.

Celebrating Many Ways to Give

Through the years, our supporters have found countless meaningful ways to support the clients of God's Love.
