In June, we received the sad news that our founder, Ganga Stone, passed away. Ganga was fearless in her vision of caring New Yorkers giving their time, love, and energy to others. She was an original New York City hero, bringing meals, hope, and dignity to people dying from AIDS almost 40 years ago. Ganga's unwavering belief in the joy of service and the triumph of human compassion was inspiring. For the past 18 months, we have drawn on everything Ganga taught us to meet the challenges of the COVID pandemic. We are honored to continue her legacy of life-saving work for everyone who needs God's Love We Deliver.

In that spirit, if you have visited us at God's Love lately you will experience the sense of renewal that inspires our work on a daily basis. And while our staff and volunteers were among those Essential Workers honored at the Hometown Heroes Parade in July, we know the pandemic is not over. We remain vigilant in following all COVID-19 protocols to ensure that our clients, volunteers and staff are as safe as possible and that we can continue our operation without interruption.

At God's Love we maintain an appropriate measure of caution while some activities begin returning to normal. Our 5th annual Love Rocks NYC concert, co-produced by John Varvatos, Greg Williamson and Nicole Rechter and held at Beacon Theatre was a huge success and

Building the Case for Medically Tailored Meals

While many of us at God's Love know that "Food is Medicine," our research team has been actively building out the science to support that statement.

In partnership with New York-Presbyterian (NYP) and the Columbia University Medical Center (CUMC), we recently launched a research study to measure the impact of medically tailored meals (MTM) on quality of life, physical functioning and use of inpatient and emergency services among patients with congestive heart failure. Dr. Rachel Bijou, a cardiologist at NYP-CUMC, is the principal investigator on the initiative. In collaboration with our partners, we have designed a rigorous study that will assess the differences in health outcomes before and after receiving six months of MTMs. We have been working closely with the Cardiology and Nutrition teams at NYP Hospital in Washington Heights to recruit eligible subjects. We anticipate recruiting approximately 65 participants.

The funding for this study came from the Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment (DSRIP), a policy funding healthcare innovation in New York State. Recently, there has been much interest from the healthcare community on how social care services can be integrated into the standard of care for patients. MTMs are an innovative strategy to address malnutrition and lower cost of care for patients with complex illnesses.



We hope that this work will further demonstrate the impact our meals have on the lives of individuals living with serious disease and help further policies to increase access to MTMs across the state and country. We look forward to sharing results with you in the months ahead!

Policy Wins! National Symposium, Pilot Bill Introduced and Congressional Roundtable Testimony

This has been a season of significant policy shifts and successes. Here's a quick round-up.

This September, God's Love We Deliver convened the 11th Annual Food is Medicine Coalition (FIMC) National Symposium, attended by peer nonprofit, medically tailored meal (MTM) providers from across the country. Amid a global pandemic that has further illustrated the impact of healthcare disparities on low-income communities of color, it was meaningful to gather around the Symposium theme: Health Equity in Action. Across five tracks of content covering Policy, Healthcare Contracting, Operations, Nutrition and Development, the over 300 attendees walked away with cutting-edge research, peer learning, actionable items, and updates on healthcare innovations across the country. We finished the Symposium with closing remarks from long-time food

is medicine champion, Congressman Jim McGovern of Massachusetts, the Chair of the Rules Committee, and the Co-Chair of the House Hunger Caucus.

In addition to the success of the Symposium, we have seen major advances in spreading the word about the power of medically tailored meals. On September 1, Karen Pearl testified at a roundtable hearing of the Rules Committee: Ending Hunger in America: Food As Medicine. This was the seventh in a series of Committee events highlighting the reality of food insecurity in America and examining the steps that Congress and the Biden administration can take to equitably combat it. On the same day, Mr. McGovern along with all 25 Chairs of House Committees, sent a letter to President Biden, calling on him to convene a national conference to end hunger.

Shortly following the Symposium, Mr. McGovern and other members of the Bipartisan Food Is Medicine Working Group re-introduced the Medically Tailored Home-Delivered Meal Demonstration Pilot Act of 2021 (H.R.5370). The bill would establish a multi-state Medicare MTM pilot program, while providing the outcomes data we need to build a more resilient and cost-effective health care system.

Thoughtful policy changes such as these are steps in the right direction. We believe the time is now to fully fund and implement our transformative food is medicine intervention as key to achieving health equity across the country. Let's advocate!

Remembering Ganga Stone

October 30, 1941 – June 2, 2021

We reflect with great admiration on the life of God's Love We Deliver founder Ganga Stone, a fearless visionary who crafted a mission and model to build a better New York by providing food, dignity, and love for some of our most vulnerable residents living with critical illness.

Friend and co-founder Jane Best says, "It was a great honor in my life to work side by side with her...to feed so many people in such a desperate situation, bringing a meal and a smile, and to create the opportunity for so many to experience the joy of volunteering."

Ganga was working as a hospice volunteer in 1985 when she paid a visit to Richard Sale, a man dying from HIV/AIDS. Seeing that he was too sick to shop or cook for himself, Ganga realized that something as simple as a delivered meal can offer love and dignity to someone who is ill—and that nutritionally tailored meals could support medical treatment.

While delivering a meal to Richard, she was walking down the street, meal bags in hand, when a local minister told her, "You're not just delivering food, you're delivering God's love." This became the name of a new organization that began with one simple act of kindness and expanded into the organization we are today.

When HIV/AIDS was ravaging NYC, Ganga's skill in enlisting volunteers meant those living in isolation received not only nutritious meals but also a smile and a visit from someone who cared. The small operation that started in her apartment now nourishes more than 10,000 New Yorkers annually, having cooked and home-delivered more than 2.4 million meals last year.

Thousands have found purpose at God's Love, helping their ailing neighbors by helping cook and deliver meals. Ganga always felt great joy in her work, whether delivering meals across the city, stirring soup with friends, or distributing donation cans to countless supportive businesses. Over the years, Ganga stayed in touch. She never stopped offering advice and telling us how proud she was of our continued efforts to deliver meals, with compassion and love, to those who are sick and hungry. We are honored to carry on her life-affirming efforts. Thank you, Ganga. You will be forever in our hearts.

Launching our Food and Nutrition Program for Veterans Living with PTSD

With support from Craig Newmark, the Bob Woodruff Foundation, PsychArmor, and the NYC Department of Veteran Affairs, God's Love has launched a pilot program to assist veterans with a PTSD diagnosis who cannot shop or cook for themselves. During this six-month pilot, which started June 28, enrolled veterans will receive ten medically tailored meals weekly to meet needs specific to their PTSD diagnosis.

To determine their meal plan, clients will receive a nutrition assessment. Throughout the program, ongoing nutrition counseling will be available to them. Meals will also be offered to qualifying members of each veteran's household, including caregivers over 65 years old and children under the age of 18.

Of course, at God's Love we know that celebration is an important part of life. Veterans on the program will receive a

birthday cake on their birthday, as well as holiday meals, like our special Thanksgiving meal, and our Winter Feast delivery in December.

Our Nutrition, Client Services, and Delivery teams have trained to work with veterans and individuals with PTSD. The teams participated in clinical, trauma-informed care, and communications training to provide the very best services to the veteran community.

Our partner, Craig Newmark, founder of craigslist and craigstable, is making this program possible. Craig says, "I seriously want to support our veterans and the team at God's Love We Deliver who do such critical work to end nutrition insecurity in our city. Veterans deserve better and they deserve more, and I know that the nutritious meals they'll receive from God's Love – along with a smile and even a birthday cake on their birthday – will make all the difference in the

world to our Veterans' health and quality of life."

God's Love We Deliver would like to thank the Bob Woodruff Foundation for helping us connect all the dots. We also thank our referral partners: James J. Peters VA Medical Center, NYC Mayor's Office of Disability Services, The Veterans Mental Health Coalition of NYC administered by Vibrant Emotional Health, and VetConnectNYC, a referral platform run by the NYC Department of Veteran Affairs and UniteUs. We look forward to continuing the development of our Veterans program. Thank you to all who made this work possible.

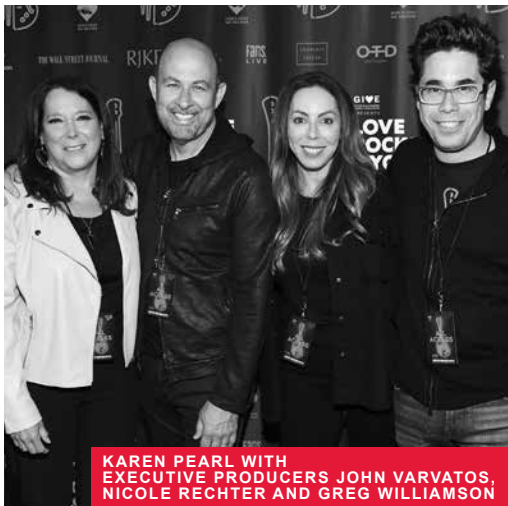
Love Rocks Brings Down the House

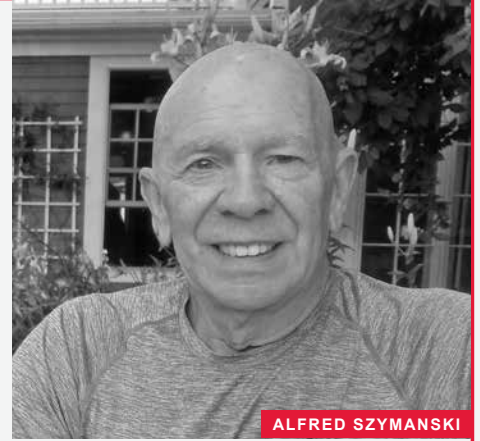

Nourishing Bodies, Hearts, and Minds

From the beginning of the pandemic last year, my colleagues in the Nutrition Services Department at God's Love were inundated with phone calls. Not just new clients, but people already on the program were presenting with a wider range of health issues than ever before. These were health emergencies that included urgent nutrition needs along with depression, anxiety, untreated or worsening behavioral health issues, housing worries, and more.

At first, we were helping clients on a case-by-case basis. But we soon realized we needed a more proactive strategy. It was clear that many of our clients were isolated and in need of more help in addition to our medically tailored meal program and nutrition counseling.

What we needed was a reference guide for our staff. Our team of Registered Dietitian Nutritionists quickly developed a new *Community Food and Health Resource Guide*. The Guide is a great new toolkit for clients, providers, and community members. It contains local social services resources including how to apply for SNAP benefits, and how to access mental health resources.

Of course, our focus on good nutrition is what makes God's Love special. We made sure that the Guide includes a section on food safety and cooking, as well as additional food resources in the community that may be appropriate for prospective clients, former clients, and others in need of nourishment.

Our new *Community Food and Health Resource Guide* has been helpful to current clients of God's Love, and it also serves as an additional support for clients leaving

the program when they are managing better with their illness. We're sharing it with clients via mail or email, and a Spanish version is nearly complete. You can find the Guide on our website. We are happy to provide this collection of community resources for anyone in need!

NUTRITION:

Sliced Pork Tenderloin with Mushroom Brandy Cream Sauce

Autumn is my favorite season in New York City. As the humidity finally breaks and the temperatures begin to drop, city dwellers reach for their favorite wool sweaters and oversized hoodies. We also start turning on the oven again, finding comfort and warmth in the modern hearth of the apartment dweller.

This recipe uses two of my family's most loved ingredients, mushrooms and pork.

If you've never cooked pork tenderloin before, you'll be surprised at how easy and affordable it is. It's a very tender cut of meat that typically weighs a little over a pound. It cooks quickly after searing on the stove and finishing in a hot oven. Just remember to not overcook it as pork tenderloin will become rather dry if cooked past medium.

Mushrooms. People either love them or hate them. Personally, I don't think I could live without them! This recipe calls for a combination of mushrooms if possible. Most grocery stores will have white button, shiitake, cremini, or portobello. All of these are fine. But if you have a favorite farmer's market (or know an experienced upstate forager) you can use black trumpets, hedgehogs, hen of the woods and puffballs. Wild mushrooms can elevate everyday recipes into restaurant quality dishes. Plus, they'll truly solidify your reputation as a "fungi"! (See what I did there? Pun intended.)

Hope you enjoy this rich, creamy fall dish.

NUTRITION RECIPE:

Sliced Pork Tenderloin with Mushroom Brandy Cream Sauce

For Spice Rub

- 1 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon Italian seasoning, dried rosemary, dried oregano, smoked paprika, ground cumin, or any combination
- ¼ teaspoon ground black pepper

- 1 1 ¼ pound pork tenderloin
- 1-2 Tablespoons olive oil

For Mushroom Brandy Cream Sauce

- 8-12 ounces assorted mushrooms, trimmed and sliced
- 1 large shallot, minced
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- ½ cup brandy, dry white wine or sherry
- ¾ cup chicken stock
- 1 cup heavy cream
- Salt and pepper, to taste
- Fresh herbs to garnish, chopped parsley, chives, etc. (optional)

Method

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees.
2. Mix ingredients for the spice rub. Remove the pork tenderloin from its packaging and pat it dry using paper towels. Season the tenderloin well with the spice rub.
3. Preheat an oven-proof skillet on the stove over medium high heat. Add the olive oil and swirl to coat the bottom of the pan. Add the pork tenderloin and sear until golden brown all over.
4. Transfer the skillet to the oven and roast the tenderloin for approximately 15 minutes, or until the internal temperature of the pork reaches 145 degrees. Transfer the tenderloin to a plate and tent loosely with foil.
5. To make the sauce, return the skillet to the stove top over medium high heat. Add the mushrooms and sauté until golden brown, adding a little more oil or butter to the pan if needed.
6. Add the minced shallot and garlic, stirring well. Add the brandy or wine to deglaze the pan, scraping up any bits that remain stuck to the bottom of the skillet. Add the chicken stock, continuing to stir.
7. Add the heavy cream and cook until sauce reduces to desired consistency. Adjust seasoning with salt and pepper as necessary. Remove the sauce from heat and finish with half of the fresh herbs, if using.
8. To serve, slice tenderloin thinly and divide on four dinner plates, fanning out the slices for presentation. Top each portion with sauce. Garnish with the remaining fresh herbs, if using. Serve with your favorite side dishes. This recipe is great with steamed vegetables, potatoes, polenta, or rice.

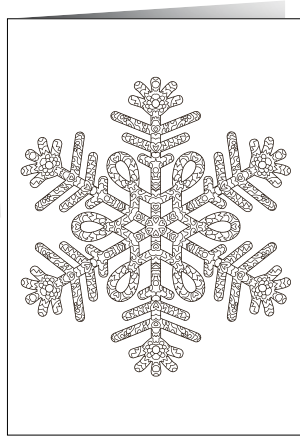
